## **Overview**

The University of Nova Gorica (UNG) is a private, research oriented university, founded by two Slovene research institutes (Jozef Stefan Institute and the Scientific Research Centre of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts) and two Slovene Municipalities. UNG's activity includes higher education at the undergraduate and graduate levels, as well as scientific research and expert activity. UNG started its operations in the 1995. Its former name Nova Gorica Polytechnic was changed together with its formal status in 2006, when it became the University of Nova Gorica. Today it comprises seven schools and eleven research units.



## **Mission Statement**

The University of Nova Gorica (UNG) aims to be a research oriented and student friendly university, where knowledge is formed within a harmonious relationship between students and researchers, and transferred to younger generations and into business environment. UNG strives to provide the highest quality education on undergraduate and graduate level and perform scientific research with a competitive advantage in an international context, as well as ensure their comprehensive integration into local, national and international spheres. UNG is strongly oriented to international collaborations with similar institutions around the world and prepares joint international study programs.
